Bonus Reading

"The Law" included more than the 10 Commandments.

- The 10 commandments were no more special than other commandments. In Matthew 22:36-37, a lawyer asked, ³⁶ "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" ³⁷ And (Jesus) said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." (from Deuteronomy 6:5)
- The Jews also spoke of "the law" in Deuteronomy, when citing an act that was "commanded":

 "Moses, in the law, commanded" stoning. *John 8:5*
- Jesus included the Psalms as part of "the Law." In John 15:25: "The word that is written in their Law must be fulfilled: 'They hated me without a cause." (from Psalm 69:4)

The Old Covenant

- the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms was a single unit, a "package deal." See Luke 24:44.
 - It was ALL "nailed to the cross." Colossians 2:14
