Bonus Reading

Non-Jews Becoming God's People

- Acts 10 & 11 Peter first preaches to non-Jews, opening the doors to the kingdom for the Gentiles. He then defends God's actions at his hands.
- Acts 15 The Holy Spirit, through the apostles and elders, settles the matter once and for all that Gentiles do not have to obey the Law of Moses. The ruins of the "tent of David" are rebuilt so that Gentiles, "the remnant of mankind," may seek the Lord. Salvation is the same for Jews and non-Jews!
- Romans 3 Justification by faith in Jesus; Romans 4:1-12 Justification of Abraham apart from works of the Law of Moses
- Romans 15:1-21 Salvation for the Gentiles in prophecy and in Jesus' and Paul's ministries
- Ephesians 2; 3:1-12 God's eternal purpose of joining Jew and non-Jew as "one man" in the church
- Colossians 2 The passing of the Law of Moses and its various requirements
