## Faith & Works

"You can't work your way to heaven."

#### God expects action.

Hearers must be doers: Matthew 7:24; James 1:22

"Faith apart from works is dead," and "useless."

- James 2:26 (also vv. 17, 20)

Faith-based action has always been necessary to accept God's grace. For example,

- Joshua conquering the city of Jericho, Joshua chapter 6
- Naaman receiving miraculous cleansing of his leprosy,
   2 Kings chapter 5
- Abraham offering Isaac. "Faith was active along with his works, and faith was completed by his works."
  - James 2:22 (See Genesis 15:1-6; 22:1-18.)

You see that a person is justified by works and not by faith alone. - James 2:24

### Our actions ("obedience," "works") are not "works of the law."

27 Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded.

By what kind of law? By a law of works?

No, but by the law of faith. 28 For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.

- Romans 3:27-28

### Our actions simply show our faith. They're sure nothing to brag about!

<sup>8</sup> For by **grace** you have been **saved through faith**. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not a result of works, so that no one may boast. – **Ephesians 2:8-9** 

Taking action to earn our salvation is ... impossible!
But, taking action to show our faith is ... essential!
