Inferiority complex: "I don't belong to the body." 1 Cor. 12:15-17
Be glad the apostle Paul didn't think that way!

[Paul was thankful to be put into service for Jesus in spite of his evil past conduct. He saw himself as the foremost of sinners who received mercy.] 1 Timothy 1:12-16

Superiority complex: "I have no need of you." 1 Cor. 12:18-27

Be glad Jesus Christ didn't think that way!
