

# **Bonus Reading**

**Non-Jews  
Becoming God's  
People**

**Acts 10 & 11** – Peter first preaches to non-Jews, opening the doors to the kingdom for the Gentiles. He then defends God's actions at his hands.

**Acts 15** – The Holy Spirit, through the apostles and elders, settles the matter once and for all that **Gentiles do not have to obey the Law of Moses**. The ruins of the “tent of David” are rebuilt so that **Gentiles**, “the remnant of mankind,” may seek the Lord. **Salvation is the same for Jews and non-Jews!**

**Romans 3** – Justification by faith in Jesus; **Romans 4:1-12** – Justification of Abraham apart from works of the Law of Moses

**Romans 15:1-21** – Salvation for the Gentiles in prophecy and in Jesus' and Paul's ministries

**Ephesians 2; 3:1-12** – God's eternal purpose of joining Jew and non-Jew as “one man” in the church

**Colossians 2** – The passing of the Law of Moses and its various requirements
